Under normal circumstances, through our 32 member agencies such as Prince of Peace, Salvation Army and St. John's, we serve over 4,200 households a month. This is all done with 6 1/2 paid employees and many volunteers. Since the Pandemic began, they have worked countless overtime hours to make sure that our residents are cared for. There is no other non-profit in Mercer County that serves this many people and you can be assured that your donated dollars are well-spent. It has been an honor to be part of such a well-run organization with such dedicated staff who view their work time as much more than a job.


