We've accomplished so much over the summer with your help!

Myron's Meal Mobile, Community Food Warehouse's summer feeding program, completed its first season and provided 5,000 hot meals!

The retrofitted school bus traveled to the communities of Farrell,
Grove City, Greenville, Sharpsville, Sharon and Transfer.

Special thanks to Emily Wood, Meal Bus Coordinator and Bus Driver, Jean Sinkus, Weber Catering & Events, Whole Life Services and the dozens of volunteers, donors, Board of Directors, and staff who made Myron's Meal Mobile a success!

In addition to Myron's Meal Mobile, you may have noticed our truck in your neighborhood distributing fresh produce and shelf stable food. We have started to expand access to nutritious food throughout the county by hosting Mobile Pantry food distributions.

The Mobile Pantry food distribution model is designed to meet the needs of our friends and neighbors who reside in rural communities and/or communities where there is limited access to grocery stores and traditional food pantries. So far, we've reached hundreds of households in Greenville, West Middlesex, and Hermitage!

Produce season was and continues to be plentiful and greatly appreciated by those who receive the bounty! Thousands of pounds of tomatoes, peppers, zucchini, squash, cucumbers, corn, potatoes, onions, peaches and apples flowed through the Warehouse and into the hands of our hungry friends and neighbors.

Summertime may have ended, but our work to feed those who are hungry continues. As the months grow colder and holidays draw near, the need for food assistance will undoubtedly increase. The good news is, we have opportunities for you to help!

September is Hunger Action Month—a month dedicated to driving awareness and inspiring action to help end hunger in America on a national scale and right here in Mercer County. Hunger should not be an impossible choice. Please visit our website to learn how you can join the movement!
