This year is no exception to the hard choices that some of our friends and neighbors are facing. In fact, with the increased cost of groceries and gasoline, the choices are multiplying – choosing between eating and purchasing medications, eating or paying their electric or gas heating bill, eating or paying for gasoline to get back and forth to work.

Nearly 15,000 neighbors in Mercer County are food insecure, 18% of those neighbors are children.

In 2022, Community Food Warehouse served record numbers of children, families, and seniors through all of our direct distribution programs including: MilitaryShare, Mobile Pantry, Myron's Meal Mobile and PA Senior Food Box.

Additionally, each month, Community Food Warehouse provides food to more than 4,200 households through 30 food pantries and feeding sites across Mercer County.

Simply put, we could not meet this ever-growing need without your unwavering support.

On behalf of those who receive the food they need, thank you for your generosity, and we wish you and your families a joyous holiday season and a peace-filled New Year.


